
A-STEP-BY-STEP SHORT COURSE TO HELP YOU OPERATE THE CLUB LIGHTING CONTROLLER OF THE YEAR

■ INTRODUCTION

We think that most people tend to skip over the introduction to instruction books — as we do ourselves — but in this particular instance, a little more than a cursory glance will be worthwhile.

If you have not yet been introduced to the Orion, we ought to explain that it is a highly sophisticated 24|channel, totally programmable lighting controller. It contains 1000 steps of memory which can be divided between 99 separate patterns.

The basic principle of the Orion, is that it has been programmed to the lighting design of the venue, and you, the User, are able to choose, and in some cases modify, the programmed patterns the designer has decided to put into memory.



Not all designers will use all the 99 possible patterns however, indeed it is quite possible to design one continuous lighting show (1 pattern) — of 99 steps! So don't get worried if your Orion doesn't appear to have that many patterns in memory; it's the way the designer planned it. You may also find a pattern of static lighting. Don't worry, it's there for a reason — after all you don't need flashing pin spots whilst the cabaret is working!

Just a small word of advice — this machine has been designed to make life easier for you.

All the hard work has been done by the designer. Take your time, learn it a bit at a time, and remember:-

When in doubt, SuperAuto will help you out.

■ USERS MANUAL TOTALLY AUTOMATIC


You are the fortunate one because someone else has already done the hard work in advance.

All you need to do is Switch On.




■ SEMI AUTOMATIC

You have the best of both worlds, you can choose to operate the Orion, or just leave it to work away by itself.



DJ CONTROL


Basically the same sequence that applies to the Semi-Automatic System, applies in this instance.



NOTE: Live operation, i.e. direct automatic transfer of selected patterns and modifications is possible if the transfer button is held down for 1 second and locked on. To remove press transfer again briefly.

■ PROGRAMMED TOUCH PANEL CONTROL

You have all the possibilities that are illustrated to the Left of this page, plus the added extra of the Touch Panel.



Remember: If you latch on, it must be cleared off by the touch pad first. We suggest you "Latch On", then touch and hold to clear, then latch another Channel whilst releasing the first, to get a continuous show.
